## PRECAUTIONS FOR PATIENTS RECEIVING RADIOACTIVE IODINE

- 1. The patient will maintain a prudent distance from others for at least the first week (especially pregnant women and children).
- 2. The patient will sleep alone in a room for at least one week.
- 3. The patient will not travel by airplane or mass transportation for at least one week.
- 4. The patient will not travel on a prolonged automobile trip with others for at least one week.
- 5. The patient will have sole use of a bathroom for at least one week.
- 6. The patient will drink plenty of fluids for at least the first 2 days and urinate frequently. (Male patients should sit down.)
- 7. The patient will not eat (solids) 2 hours prior to and 2 hours following the administration of his/her Iodine-131. (Clear liquids are ok; water, tea, soft drinks, fruit juice)
- 8. The patient will chew gum or suck on hard candy to encourage the flow of saliva for at least the first week. This should be done every 1 ½ to 2 hours when awake (as soon as patient wakes up) and at bedtime. It is not necessary to wake up in the middle of the night.
- 9. The patient will use disposable cups, plates, spoons, forks, etc. for the first week...
- 10. The patient will avoid intimate relations, deep kissing or the exchange of body fluids for the first 2 weeks.

## 11. FEMALE PATIENTS SHOULD NOT BECOME PREGNANT FOR 6 MONTHS.

- 12. The patient will flush the toilet twice.
- 13. The patient will shower daily.
- 14. The patient will wash all clothing and bedding separately from their family members the first week and then may wash together.
